



So You're a Groomsman, Now What?

The following is a list of duties you are expected to fulfill. Depending upon your geographical location, some of these duties may or may not apply to you. Please confer with the bride to be sure of what is expected of you. Enjoy!

- ❖ Plan or attend pre-wedding parties in the couple's honor
- ❖ Help the groom to select the men's wedding day wardrobe, if asked
- ❖ Attend the men's tuxedo shopping trip, or. . .
- ❖ Send in a size card for tuxedo rental
- ❖ Pay for own tuxedo rental
- ❖ Attend any coed bridal showers
- ❖ Organize a group shower gift, or give an individual gift to the couple
- ❖ Provide assistance and support to the groom during the planning stages
- ❖ Organize and attend the bachelor party, if applicable
- ❖ Attend the rehearsal and rehearsal dinner
- ❖ Arrive on time the morning of the wedding
- ❖ Pose for pre-wedding pictures
- ❖ Wait with the groom for the start of the ceremony, or participate in the processional as asked
- ❖ Stand in line during the ceremony and participate in the ceremony as requested
- ❖ Participate in the recessional
- ❖ Stand in the receiving line, if asked
- ❖ Pose for post-wedding pictures
- ❖ Participate in special dances and events at the reception
- ❖ See the couple off for their getaway
- ❖ Help transport the couple's wedding gifts to their home or other safe place
- ❖ Attend any post-wedding parties
- ❖ Attend the morning-after wedding breakfast
- ❖ Help with post-wedding tasks, such as returning rental items or cleaning up
- ❖ Help organize the timely return of the men's tuxedos and other rented items
- ❖ Help out with any tasks while the couple is honeymooning, such as house or pet-sitting
